## Access to Information Procedure Rule 4

### **Notice of Private Item - development of integrated health and social care in Scarborough and Ryedale**

The County Council's Constitution provides that at least 28 clear days before a private meeting (a meeting, or part of a meeting, of the executive decision making body during which the public are excluded) the executive decision-making body must give notice of its intention to hold the meeting in private (including a statement of the reasons for holding it in private) by making the notice available at County Hall and at the venue for the meeting (if different) and publishing it on the Council's website.

It is anticipated that on 25 July 2017 a report by the Corporate Director Health and Adult Services regarding the development of integrated health and social care in Scarborough and Ryedale will be considered by the Executive. The intention to make this key decision is published on the Forward Plan.

It has recently become apparent that the report will contain exempt information. The information anticipated to be contained in the report is classed as exempt as it is commercially sensitive information and it is considered that the public interest in maintaining the exemption outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information. This part of the meeting may therefore be held in private.

This Notice gives the required 28 days' notice of the intention to hold this part of the Executive meeting in private.
