

Richmondshire Area Committee – 11 January 2017**Items raised by Members of the Committee – County Councillor John Blackie****(i) Call for a free cash dispenser from HSBC in Hawes following the closure of its Bank in the town - Starvation in the Upper Dales !!!**

A new sight on the footpaths of Hawes recently has been small gangs of local people and visitors alike pacing up and down whilst claiming they were being starved of their favourite fish and chips from the Hawes Chippie for the want of cash in their pockets due to the failure of the Barclays Bank cash machine in the town. The Chippie does not accept credit or debit cards, like several of the traders in the town, and the Barclays cash point was out of action for 10 days.

It was always the major concern of myself as local Councillor, and the traders in the town, that the loss of the HSBC Bank in Hawes, which was closed in October after 150 years in the town without any consultation whatsoever with the local community, would leave our remote community reliant on a single cash machine in a Barclays Bank open just 3 days a week.

It was fortunate that the Post Office in Hawes, under threat of closure itself until the Upper Wensleydale Community Partnership (UWCP), of which I am volunteer Executive Chairman, stepped in nearly 3 years ago with an offer to relocate it into the Community Office / NYCC Hawes Library and Resource Centre, has been able to take on as a result of a national initiative many of its routine personal and business banking functions after the HSBC Bank abandoned its interest in the town. This has led to a large increase in footfall at the Community Office but nothing like on the level we experienced whilst the Barclays Cash Machine was out of order.

During this time, when news went around that you could use your debit / credit cards at The Post Office for cash withdrawals, there was well over 300 callers a day queuing at our Counter for cash. On a Saturday I was a volunteer helping out in the Community Office, and in the 3.5 hours we were open over 200 people took out cash. The only other source of cash in the town was the Spar shop and they were just as busy in giving Cashback to many of their customers.

This is winter in Hawes so you can imagine how these numbers could be dwarfed in summer at the height of the visitor season.

The local economy in Hawes depends on a significant amount of cash being available and in circulation on a 24/7 basis, as our experience demonstrates, but if the Barclays cash machine breaks down again, as it will, the Post Office and Spar can only offer it when they are open.

I have investigated the situation in Masham, where there is a stand-alone 24/7 cash machine by its bus shelter, which was supplied free of charge by HSBC when it closed its branch there. HSBC also funds the re-stocking of the machine with cash as and when it is needed, and I am advised it is in constant use in the day and during the evening. Barclays has a branch in Hawes, open 3 days a week, just like Hawes.

Interestingly this free offer of a cash machine was never made to Hawes when HSBC announced the closure of its branch. I am now pressing HSBC hard to make the same offer for Hawes, using my role as Executive Chairman of the UWCP and volunteer sub-Postmaster for the town as well as local Councillor, and asking HSBC to be fair to a deeply rural community who has loyally provided custom to the bank over many years.

I have identified 3 possible sites for the cash machine. It is clearly essential we have a back up 24/7 cash machine here in the town.

I will be involving the local MP, Rishi Sunak, in my quest, as he was quick to call HSBC to account and promote the use of Hawes Post Office as an alternative. I am asking for the support of North Yorkshire County Council's Richmondshire Area Committee today in its role of promoting the social and economic well-being of the local communities within its remit.

Hopefully the sight of Hawes fish and chip addicts looking desperate for a fix will be a thing of the past soon. And the other traders in the town with or without card machines, will have their tills ringing to the sound of cash again !!

(ii) The Little White Bus - The revised Richmondshire Rover Service and other LWB services provided with financial support from North Yorkshire County Council

I attach the timetables of the revised Richmondshire Rover service, as reported to the last NYCC Richmondshire Area Committee, which commenced on 29th November 2016. **I also attach copies** of the LWB timetables for the Swaledale Shuttle and the Wensleydale Voyager which commenced on 7th November and show a small number of minor revisions to these services. And finally **I attach a picture** of the brand new LWB £65,000 Mercedes Treka 16 seater minibus awarded to the LWB from the £25 million Community Minibus fund established by Central Government.

May I add that the very helpful staff at the Integrated Passenger Transport (IPT) unit of North Yorkshire County Council (NYCC) provides the LWB with 1st class support for our services, as well as full technical assistance / vehicle servicing via its Ringway external contractor. The LWB very gratefully acknowledges the assistance provided by the IPT, which has been an essential factor in the success of our services. **The LWB now operates 10 minibuses and a Land Rover 4x4,**

and will carry 60,000 passengers this year. It employs a part-time Operations Manager and 8 part-time drivers, alongside an enthusiastic team of 40 public-spirited volunteer drivers.

The LWB delivers all the local bus services in the Upper Dales. Its services continue to be extremely well received by the travelling public, be they local people or visitors to North Yorkshire.

FEATURES OF THE REVISED RICHMONDSHIRE ROVER SERVICE

Residents of Catterick Village / Tunstall / Scotton / Richmond

- Will be able to visit (and return from) the shops and services on offer in 5 different Market Towns, without having to change the bus they are travelling on. These towns are Northallerton, Barnard Castle, Bedale, Ripon and Richmond, the exact towns depending on the day of the week. The RR timetable allows one hour 30 minutes at a minimum, and often more time, to spend in these Market Towns before returning home on the LWB.
- These new travel opportunities are in addition to a twice a day, 5 days a week, core RR return service between Catterick Village / Scotton / Tunstall / Princes Gate / Richmond.
- By changing in Bedale on Tuesdays and Thursdays will be able to catch a 73 Dales and District bus to Northallerton, spend up to 1 hour 30 minutes there, and returning to Bedale to catch the RR home.
- This is in addition to the Market Day service direct to Northallerton on Wednesdays which allows 2 hours 25 minutes there before returning back on the LWB. This extended time would facilitate say a visit to an Outpatients clinic or relative in hospital (subject to special visiting permission) at the Friarage, or an appointment with the many specialist professional services in Northallerton, or a visit to County Hall.
- The core RR service on Monday - Friday leaving Catterick Village at 9.30 goes via Tunstall and Scotton, and now allows extra time for a swift morning shopping visit to Princes Gate (1 hour) or Richmond (50 minutes), before returning on the same route to Catterick Village. Thursdays are slightly different - please check the timetable for exact details.
- Similarly the core RR service on Monday - Friday leaving Catterick Village at 14.30 now allows extra time for a sharp afternoon shopping visit to Princes Gate (40 minutes) or Richmond (30 minutes), before returning to Catterick Village. Thursdays are slightly different - please check the timetable for exact details.

- Our LWB contracted service twice on a Saturday between Richmond – Princes Gate – Scotton – Tunstall and return is operated by the Swaledale Shuttle service. Please see the attached timetable for details.

Residents of Scorton, Moulton, Middleton Tyas

- can visit (and return from) the shops and services in Barnard Castle on Mondays and Fridays, and Bedale and Ripon on Thursdays, without having to change the bus they are travelling on. There is plenty of time allowed in these towns before returning home on the LWB.

Residents of villages in North Richmondshire including Eppleby, Forcett, and Caldwell

- can use the RR direct service to visit (and return from) the shops and services in Barnard Castle on Mondays and Fridays, allowing 1 hour 35 minutes there before returning home on the LWB.

Residents in Bedale

- can now enjoy a direct and fast return RR service to and from Ripon, allowing one hour 35 minutes or more to visit the shops and services there, on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.

The Leyburn – Bedale – Leyburn RR service

The revised RR service maintains the Monday - Friday late afternoon service between Leyburn and Bedale, with a departure from Leyburn at 16.45 and departures from Bedale at 16.05 and 17.20.

These services augment the morning and early afternoon services provided by NYCC Fleet, and have proved invaluable to visitors to Hawes and Upper Wensleydale to return to Northallerton and onward destinations after a day in the Dales, and residents and college students returning to Leyburn after work or studying in Bedale and Northallerton. Certain services call at Newton-le-Willows, Finghall, Spennithorne and Hunton.

The revised RR service introduces improvements to the Saturday LWB service between Leyburn and Bedale, with additional journeys in the middle of the day, to meet the many requests from passengers keen to return home earlier from a visit to Northallerton via the Dales and District 73 service connection in Bedale than has been possible on the pilot RR service. There are also longer layover times in Leyburn to allow passengers on the RR service the opportunity to browse its shops and services before returning home or continuing their onward travel.

Interlining with other LWB services (please see the attached LWB timetables)

By changing from the RR service at Princes Gate or Richmond you can take the Swaledale Shuttle service for a daily return journey to Reeth, and a one-way journey to Muker and Keld, or a one way journey on the Wensleydale Voyager to Upper Wensleydale including Hawes, Askrigg and Aysgarth.

There are a range of connections onto the LWB Wensleydale Voyager service at Leyburn from / to Hawes and the villages in Upper Wensleydale from the Monday - Friday afternoon / Saturday all day RR Leyburn - Bedale - Leyburn service.

Concessionary Fares / Ride Around for a Pound

Concessionary Fare passes may be used on all the journeys shown on the attached Richmondshire Rover service timetable. The under 18 young person's Ride Around for a Pound special fare of £1 per journey may be used on the Richmondshire Rover service from 5.00 pm on weekdays, any time on a Saturday, and any time and any day of the week during school holidays.
