3.2 Previously the Committee, at its Meeting held on 8 June 2015, agreed to adopt a refreshed style of meetings, with the recurring business of the Committee dealt with during the first phase of the meeting, together with any other reports relating to significant local issues that required the consideration of the Committee.

#### 4.0 Topics for business suggested under the previously adopted arrangements for future meetings

4.1 In line with arrangements adopted in 2015 the main focus for Meetings was topics identified by the Committee as requiring in-depth analysis and investigation, culminating in recommendations for a way forward on these matters being developed for the Selby area. It was expected that some of the issues identified would require more than one meeting's consideration for a complete analysis to be undertaken. Initially the Committee concentrated on 'Infrastructure projects in the Selby District - links to Economic development'.

4.2 The Chairman and Members have identified development, and related infrastructure, in the Selby District, as an issue to continue to consider in-depth, initially, with further discussions, assisted by relevant officers taking place at today's meeting.

4.3 Other potential matters for in depth analysis are indicated below. Members may wish to consider these as potential areas for further exploration or could provide alternative suggestions:-

- Economic Development Strategies.
- “Better Together” initiative.
- Local enterprise and future investment – York/North Yorkshire/East Riding Enterprise Partnership.
- Traffic management.
- The development of appropriate skills for emerging employment opportunities
- Superfast Broadband provision,
