2.0 Ryedale Area Committee - 14 February 2018

- 18 month Experimental HGV Restriction at the Norton Level Crossing. The restrictions would come into force on 26th February 2018 and Trading Standards would monitor.

- (a) The South Tees Trust's engagement exercise in relation to the provision of sustainable services at the Friarage Hospital had now been completed and options were being developed for a public consultation exercise.
- (b) Hambleton, Richmondshire and Whitby CCG currently had a deficit of £6.5m, but this was not uncommon for CCGs who continued to deliver services throughout the area.
- (c) Members welcomed the performance of the Highway's maintenance teams during the recent freezing weather.
- (d) Further public meetings were planned in relation to car parking on the streets around the new Police HQ on Alverton Court, Northallerton.

3.3 Business scheduled for the June meeting included developments in the performance of the Yorkshire Ambulance Service, an update on Superfast Broadband and progress on the old Prison site in Northallerton.
