1.0 Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 To enable any appointments to Committees or major outside bodies to be considered.

2.0 West Yorkshire Joint Health Overview and Scrutiny Committee

The West Yorkshire Joint Health Overview Scrutiny Committee was established in December 2015 and the original members were drawn from the five West Yorkshire Health Overview and Scrutiny Committees.

The Joint Health Overview and Scrutiny Committee (JHOSC) was established to scrutinise the West Yorkshire Clinical Commissioning Groups work on the 'Healthy Futures' programme of work.

Since the spring of 2017, NHS England and NHS Improvement has established sub-regional commissioning and delivery vehicles known as Sustainability Transformation Plans, which have then evolved into Integrated Care Systems. The geography that these relate to include Harrogate Borough Council area and Craven District Council area. As such, the Chairman of the North Yorkshire County Council Scrutiny of Health Committee was invited to attend the meetings of the JHOSC as an observer.

At their meeting on 30 July 2018, the JHOSC requested that North Yorkshire County Council nominate 2 County Councillors to attend the meeting as non-voting co-opted members for the remainder of the current municipal year. After that time, the membership of the JHOSC would be reviewed with the intention of formalising County Council's position as full members of the committee.

Executive is asked to recommend the following County Councillor to Council for appointment to the West Yorkshire Joint Health Overview and Scrutiny Committee:

County Councillor Jim Clark (Chairman of the NYC Scrutiny of Health Committee).

A second County Councillor will be recommended at the next meeting of the Executive.
