Applicant	Amended Recommendation

North Yorkshire Credit Union	The application documentation is now complete and the project does not conflict with any funding criteria.
The Richard Kay Charity (Moor Monkton Village Hall)	The application documentation is now complete and the project does not conflict with any funding criteria, although the Sub-Committee, in order to ensure that any grant for this application complies with the funding criteria, may wish to identify a specific part or aspect of this event to support, eg assistance towards the costs of producing programmes, or assistance towards advertising costs.
1 st Masham Guides	The application documentation is now complete and the project does not conflict with any funding criteria.
